MEETING MINUTES and ADDENDUM TO THE OFFICER REPORT at GMANASC

The meeting was called to order at 11:05am. In attendance was James, William, Jason, Nicole, Amy, and Jessie. The Serenity Prayer was recited. James read the 12 traditions. The chairperson passed around a contact information sheet, and everyone shared their contact information. The following topics were discussed:

How should this committee use the \$500.00 annual budget for our primary purpose, to carry the message to the addict who is still suffering? Activities can provide a greater sense of community for local communities and areas in the NA Fellowship. They can also produce additional area funds. It should be kept in mind that these functions are designed to enhance NA's primary purpose, not to replace group contributions in funding area services.

There are some vacant positions on the subcommittee: Vice Chair, and Secretary. The chairperson shared the clean time requirements and the duties and responsibilities of each position.

We discussed which events this committee could organize. Some of the ideas we discussed include: GSR Orientation Day Workshop; PI Learning Day Workshop; H&I Learning Day Workshops; Other Learning Day Workshops (Sponsorship, Home Group, Service Structure); Barbecues; Concerts; Dances; Mixers; Pot Luck Dinners; Comedy Nights; Speaker Jams; Recovery, Health and Wellness Events (Other Community Organizations); New Year's Eve Celebration and Speaker Event; Halloween Costume Party (Contest) and Pot Luck Dinner; Independence Day Barbecue and Fireworks; Softball or Kickball Game, Picnic, Barbecue; Winter Events - Ice Skating, Sledding, Movie Nights; Bonfire Meetings; Second Chance Prom;

Valentine's Day Formal Dance; Fashion Show; Match Game or Other Game Nights; Easter Egg Hunt with Dinner and Meeting; Memorial Day Barbecue; Thanksgiving Dinner and Speaker Jam; and Christmas Dinner and Speaker Jam.

According to the Green Mountain Area Activities Subcommittee Guidelines, this subcommittee would have the following duties and responsibilities:

Article II (purpose)

- 1) Our purpose is to provide and maintain an atmosphere of recovery and unity and celebration throughout the GMA
- 2) To coordinate timing of activities within the GMA
- 3) To coordinate and sponsor fundraisers to help meet the financial needs of the area when directed by the GMASC.

Article III

- 1) To follow the direction of the GMA service committee in all matters
- 2) To submit a \$500 annual budget for operating expenses to the ASC.
- 3) To hold regular subcommittee meetings
- 4) To provide the ASC with complete and accurate monthly reports on the status of all ongoing projects
- 5) Submit accurate financial reports on all activities, functions or events upon completion
- 6) To ensure our event fliers and postings meet the following guidelines:
 - a. Contain NA logo or service symbol
 - b. Contain no endorsements
 - c. Clearly state the sponsoring Area (GMA)

- 7) to communicate with other groups, committees, and service areas in order to better coordinate, facilitate and support unity within all GMA events and activities
- 8) To deposit all funds into the ASC checking account
 - a) first to replenish Activities subcommittee annual budget
 - b) second to support the GMASC
- 9) Turn in all deposit slips to the ASC Treasurer

We discussed which local communities will benefit the most from events, and/or have the biggest turnouts, and/or have the right types of venues? We agreed that we should move monthly events around to a different community every month. We agreed to have a backup plan for inclement weather. The following communities would be considered: Lebanon/White River Junction; Rutland; Keene/Brattleboro; Middlebury; Bennington; Brattleboro; and Springfield.

We agreed to move forward on planning an Easter Egg Hunt - Potluck Dinner - Double Speaker Meeting. We would like to hold it on Saturday, April 22, 2017. We need to find 2 speakers for this event. We need to reserve a space and time, and possibly piggy back off the H&I Learning Day Event scheduled for that day.

We agreed to preplanning the 2nd event. We would like to plan a Memorial Day Barbecue, Speaker Meeting, and Open Discussion Meeting for Monday, May 29, 2017. We will keep discussing plans for this event. We need to reserve a space and time, we could possibly do this at one of the not so busy State Parks (on a lake). We need to find a speaker.

Dances, picnics, campouts, special speaker meetings—these events are put on by area activities subcommittees. Activities like these can provide a greater sense of community for the local NA Fellowship and produce additional area income. It should always be kept in mind, however, that these functions are designed to enhance NA's primary purpose, not to replace group contributions in funding area services.

A couple of remarks must be made regarding legalities relevant to NA activities. Most activities subcommittees distribute fliers announcing their next event to NA groups in the area. If your subcommittee's flier displays an NA logo, a small circled letter "R" (it looks like this: ®) should appear to the right of the logo. This mark shows that the logo is a registered trademark of Narcotics Anonymous worldwide and helps protect the logo from misuse outside the fellowship. For more information, see the bulletin, *Internal Use of NA Intellectual Property*, available from your World Service Office.

Some activities subcommittees have conducted raffles of one sort or another either as separate fundraising efforts or as parts of another activity. It should be noted that in many US states and in some other countries such raffles are considered gambling and, as such, are illegal. Activities subcommittees should also consider whether raffles, especially cash raffles or lotteries, appeal more to the spirit of self-interest than the spirit of voluntary support implicit in our Seventh Tradition.

The meeting closed with the Serenity Prayer. We have not scheduled a time and date for the next Activities Subcommittee meeting. The chairperson is going to call the Springfield Hospital to ask about the Cafeteria meeting rooms for April 30, 2017 at 10:00am. The
