


Nothing has really changed – attendance is steady and home group members are still holding it strong on zoom.

Hi Family,


The In from The Storm Group is still meeting in person and on Zoom. Our format ranges from reading NA literature and having topic discussions to hosting a speaker once a month.




Hi Family,


We have had great attendance. We had 12 women on Zoom last week, including a couple of newcomers. Definitely carrying and hearing the message.

Some new members have been coming since the local treatment house has lifted COVID restrictions.


While our Zoom attendance is super low (0-1 members per meeting), our in-person attendance is steady with 5 core members.



We have made a slight change to the literature we are using in our Step and Tradition Discussion meeting.




We also discussed ways to liven things up - coming off of mute to welcome members and do key tags, etc. Gonna get rowdy!




Our treasurer Laura C will be mailing a \$50 donation to area this month.

I am new at this and will be going off of what everyone else has said.


Attendance at Together We Can has been great. We have Headrest in Lebanon who attend regularly so we are getting a flow of newcomers through them.


As far as now, I believe all of our group positions are filled. We are getting a fairly decent flow of money through PayPal.
