Good Afternoon Family,

I attended Regional Service this month in person in Wyantskill, NY. It was held at the Promise of Freedom campout. I did not, however, attend the campout, I was only there for regional service.

There were 4 RCMs present (Albany-Rensselaer, Green Mountain, Mid-Hudson Valley, and Seaway Trails). Also present were the Chairperson, Regional Delegate, Policy Chairperson and the Regional Webmaster.

A long discussion was had over the concept of Consensus Based voting as opposed to Parliamentary "Roberts Rules" type voting. The Policy Subcommittee is currently working on this and will be providing a report in the upcoming months.

The Mid-Hudson Valley Area RCM (Dave B) provided copies of a flyer that the Mid-Hudson Valley Area has been handing out as a flyer as well as an item to be placed on tables at groups. This flyer contains the QR Codes for Mid-Hudson Valley, Open Arms Area, ABCD Region, Connecticut Region, Narcotics Anonymous World, Greater NY Region, Berkshire Area and Green Mountain Area. It basically provides an electronic link to all Areas and Regions surrounding the Mid-Hudson Valley and beyond. I have attached a pdf copy of this with this report.

The East Coast Convention of NA 24, which was held in Chestertown, MD in June of 2021, purchased 2,506 basic texts from the proceeds of that convention. They in turn donated these basic texts to Regions up and down the east coast, which resulted in the Green Mountain Area receiving a case. The East Coast Convention has been doing this for a number of years, and their wish for these basic texts is that they get donated to H&I facilities. I will coordinate giving these to Still Rich (our H&I Chair). (A factoid for history buffs – the very first NA convention ever held in the State of NH was the East Coast Convention on June 24-26, 1988, 34 years ago today, at UNH in Durham, NH, this convention was called A Vision of Hope).
