As a committee we decided to not carry the women's commitment to the CCHOC facility this month, and future months. We notified the facility of our plan, but did not receive a response. For now, we feel it's not a proper use of our limited resources to continue bringing in a commitment when no one wants to attend.

Our H&I Panel Coordinator position became open last month with the departure of Sam F. as our previous Coordinator. Our Committee member, Dave K., has expressed interest in serving in the role and qualified during the meeting. Our group held a vote for Dave to fulfill the Panel Coordinator position (6-Pro, 0-Con, 1-Abstention). Congratulations to Dave!
